e. The registration u/s 12AB of the Income Tax Act, 1961 does not automatically confer any right on the donors to claim deduction u/s 80G.

f. Order u/s 12AB read with section 12A does not confer any right of exemption upon the applicant u/s 11 and 12 of Income Tax Act, 1961. Such exemption from taxation will be available only after the Assessing Officer is satisfied about the genuineness of the activities promised or claimed to be carried on in each Financial Year relevant to the Assessment Year and all the provisions of law acted upon. This will be further subject to provisions of section 2(15) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

g. No change in terms of Trust Deed/ Memorandum of Association shall be effected without due procedure of law and its intimation shall be given immediately to Office of the Jurisdictional Commissioner of Income Tax. The registering authority reserves the right to consider whether any such alteration in objects would be consistent with the definition of "charitable purpose" under the Act and in conformity with the requirement of continuity of registration.

h. The Trust/ Society/ Non Profit Company shall maintain accounts regularly and shall get these accounts audited in accordance with the provisions of the section 12A(1)(b) of the Income Tax Act, 1961. Separate accounts in respect of each activity as specified in Trust Deed/ Memorandum of Association shall be maintained. A copy of such account shall be submitted to the Assessing Officer. A public notice of the activities carried on/ to be carried on and the target group(s) (intended beneficiaries) shall be duly displayed at the Registered/ Designated Office of the Organisation.

i. The Trust/ Institution shall furnish a return of income every year within the time limit prescribed under the Income Tax Act, 1961.

j. Separate accounts in respect of profits and gains of business incidental to attainment of objects shall be maintained in compliance to section 11(4A) of Income Tax Act, 1961.

k. The registered office or the principal place of activity of the applicant should not be transferred outside the jurisdiction of Jurisdictional Commissioner of Income Tax except with the prior approval.

l. No asset shall be transferred without the knowledge of Jurisdictional Commissioner of Income Tax to anyone, including to any Trust/ Society/ Non Profit Company etc.

m. The registration so granted is liable to be cancelled at any point of time if the registering authority is satisfied that activities of the Trust/ Institution/ Non Profit Company are not genuine or are not being carried out in accordance with the objects of the Trust/ Institution/ Non Profit Company.

f. The trust/society/non profit company shall file the return of income of its trust/society/non profit company as per the provisions of section 139(1)/(4A)/(4C) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

g. The approval granted through this order shall apply to the donations received only if the applicant trust/society/non profit company, established in India for charitable purpose, fulfills the conditions laid down in section 80G(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and the religious expenditure does not exceed the limit specified in section 80G(5B) of the said Act.

h. If the applicant trust/ society/ non-profit company derives any income, being profits and gains of business, it shall maintain separate books of account in respect of such business as provided in section 80G(5)(i) of the Income Tax Act,1961. Further, any donation received by the applicant shall not be used, directly or indirectly, for the purposes of such business and a certificate shall be issued to every person making a donation to the effect that the applicant maintains separate books of account in respect of the business and the donation received by it will not be used, directly or indirectly, for the purpose of the business.

Empowerment of the weaker sections can be more effective and efficient by empowering the neighborhood individuals to take active participation in uplifting the weaker sections at the grass-root level. Empowerment of weaker sections includes general strengthening that is the instructive, monetary, political, and social strengthening of the weaker sections. For empowerment of the weaker sections, there are constitutional and statutory provisions available

People above 60 years of age are considered as 'old' and constitute the 'elderly' segment of the population .The shift in age structure makes issues of social security and economic support for elderly people very crucial. India, with its predominantly agrarian based economy, has inadequate social security provisions for its older people.



PROJECT ACTIVITY PLAN AND CORE ACTIVITIES OF THE PROJECT CENTER

There will be a Project Advisory committee once in a month, to discuss the welfare issues of children and community. The project coordinator can represent the concerns of the committee to the administration office for any discussions and recommendations. Project Center

A Project Center will be taken on Rent only after a thorough survey of the place. Specific approval will be obtained from the Head Office. For a center of 75 to 89, children there should be 1 project coordinator, 2 social workers, 2 tutors, 2 cooks. The children teaching staff proportion 15 to 23.

If the children are coming in shifts, full time tutors can be recruited instead of part time tutors

Old Age Home

The Old Age Home will be equipped with all the facilities such as: Separate Dormitories, Kitchen, Dining Hall, Prayer Hall, Clean and Hygienic Bathrooms, Solar Water Heaters.

Food Menu

Each project should have a food menu. The food menu should be changed once in every 4 months. The program coordinator will be responsible for the preparation of food menu.

The program coordinator should ensure that every project provides food as per the approved food menu. The finance coordinator should have a copy of the food menu

In the case of hygiene supplies, and some basic school supplies like pencils, pen, eraser, sharpener,, quotations can be avoided, but the rate per piece should be fixed by the purchase committee.

Office supplies

Expenses relating to purchase of stationery postage charges, printing charges, photocopy charges for Administrative office use should be budgeted under this budget. Even if the budget is unavailable in the corresponding month the expense can be justified, however the expense should not exceed the annual budget for office supplies.
